BACKGROUND

HEB 11:4-7

Faith shows the reality of what we hope for and the evidence of things we cannot see. It is the assurance, the confirmation of things divinely guaranteed and it comprehends as fact what cannot be experienced by the physical senses.

Abel's story is a foreshadowing of a greater sacrifice when Jesus would die on a cross for all who would come to Him in faith.

Process of time: lit. “end of days” – a specific time for atonement to be made

HEB 11:4

“brought” – they both came to a designated place

HEB 11:4

“By faith Abel offered an acceptable sacrifice,” faith in what? Faith in the revelation of God. Faith comes by hearing, does it not? You believe what God has said. This is not some kind of nebulous faith. This is the faith that says, “I have heard God speak and I believe it is true and I will obey.”
(MacArthur)



Atonement: at-one-ment

Cain didn't recognize the need for atonement, and that's the bigger issue.

Coming to God on your own terms is what **Jude 11** calls 'the way of Cain'... it's the way of all false religion.





Still Cain was given a second chance to repent.

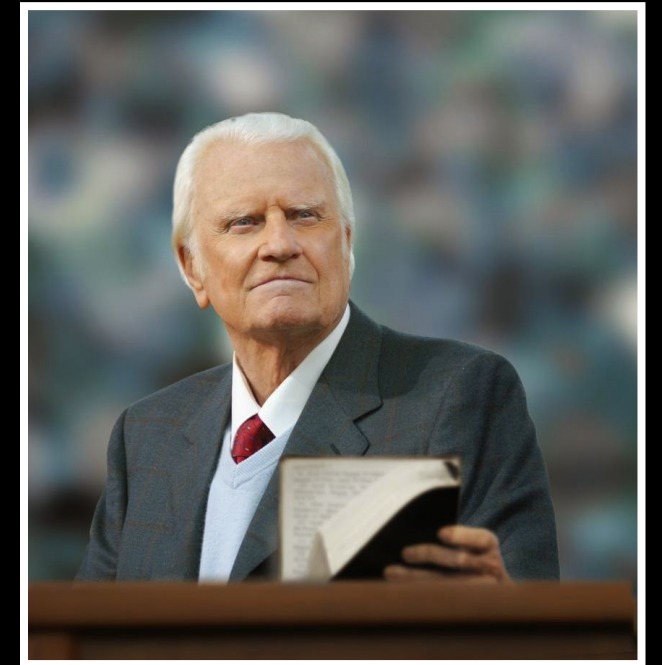
