Wisdom cries out:

IOW: Wisdom is not hidden where only an elite, select few can get to it.

Whosoever will... let them come... ask, and it will be given to you liberally... only ask in faith...



The Goodness of Lady Wisdom

Simple: willfully ignorant; gullible to a dangerous degree

Prudence: caution, discernment and action in conformity to reality

Fool: unable to deal with life in any successful, practical way

Heart: soul - mind, will and emotions

Those who love and pursue wisdom will find themselves rewarded.

They will find wisdom (**those who seek me diligently will find me**) and the blessings wisdom brings (**riches and honor...righteousness**).

*Paradoxically when wealth is sought it corrupts, but when wisdom is sought, edifying wealth is given”
