

Make Sure They Don't Miss The Grace of God Heb 12:15

Pursue peace with all *people*, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord: looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled...



(Heb 12:14-15)

...looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God (NKJV)

Exercise foresight *and* be on the watch to look [*after one another*], to see that no one falls back from *and* fails to secure God's grace (AMP)



Be sure that no one misses God's grace. (NIrV)

"look carefully" – "exercise foresight" – "see to it" – "be sure" (Episkopeo) to examine the state of affairs of something, to look after or to oversee.



Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God...(KJV)

"Lest anybody be falling back."



As members of the body of Christ we are responsible for each other. We have the task of overseeing one another in spiritual matters, so that we may grow and flourish in the grace of God and not come short of it.
