Wise: wise-hearted... one who is experienced in life.

Teaching: "the law of the wise"

Snare: The proper understanding of this Hebrew word is the lure or bait placed in a hunter's trap.

1Pe 5:8



The Bait

1Jn 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world



Understanding and obeying God's word will keep one away from many things that trap and destroy, both spiritually and materially.

"This book will keep you from sin and sin will keep you from this book."



Wise: wise-hearted... one who is experienced in life with applying scriptural truth to life's situations and circumstances...

Walks with the wise: befriends, fellowships with, hangs with, follows, admires, interacts.



Ps 119:63. I am a companion to all those who fear You, And to those who keep Your precepts

The wise person is a friend to anyone who fears God—anyone who obeys His commandments.



Fool: A stupid or silly person characterized by:

Laziness: Ecc 4:5

Arrogant: Ecc 4:13

Clueless: Ecc 2:14-16

Mouthy: Ecc 5:1



It is taken for granted that the companion of fools is also a fool and will remain rooted in their folly.

1Co 15:33 Do not be deceived: "Bad company corrupts good morals"



Wise Woman: wise-hearted... one who is experienced in life and directs her life by the counsel of God's word

Builds her house... She makes it a place of refuge where a person feels safe and accepted; where there are shared interests. She builds with an emotional connection and gives others a sense of belonging.

The Sensible

Prudent: one who is disciplined in the use of wise and careful foresight... they think things through first and put it through the filter of God's precepts and principles.



The Folly of Fools

Self-Deception: the action or practice of allowing oneself to believe that a false or unvalidated feeling, idea, or situation is true.



Turning Away from Evil

The wise appreciate evil for what it is and keeps themself far from it.

-OTOH-

The **fool rages** with uncontrolled temper and outbursts.



The Crown of the Wise

One of the ways riches come is through wisdom and hard work.

-OTOH-

For those who reject wisdom (hard work) the only crown they get for their foolishness is more folly.

The Heart of the Wise

What we are is eventually evident in what we do.

The Wise Son vs. Foolish Son

The Wise Son makes glad / The foolish son brings disgrace

"Tragically the person who needs their instruction, out of his exaggerated opinion of his self-importance, feels that he is better than his godly parents and so is intractable and incorrigible." (Waltke)



Pro 15:20

Fear of the Lord & Honor

Wisdom begins in the fear of the Lord, and true wisdom flows from it.



Pro 15:33

Fear of the Lord & Honor

Honor flows from humility.

2Co 12:9-10

"Paradoxically, the one who grants himself no glory before the glorious God in the end is crowned with the glory and wealth that give him social esteem." (Waltke)

Wisdom & Understanding

Pro 17:24 Anyone with wisdom knows what makes good sense. (CEV)

The sense seems to be that the wise see things through the lens of their wisdom – which is given by God and gained through experience...

Their wisdom makes everything else clearer and able to be understood.

Wisdom & Understanding

The fool has their eyes everywhere (the ends of the earth) except where they should be. (Luke 12:18-21)

"Our enemy's great object is to turn the mind away from what is immediate to what is indefinite, from what is plain and important to what is unsearchable, from what is personal to what is irrelevant. Many trifles take the place of the one thing that is needful." (Bridges)
