And I have the keys of Hades and of Death. Write the things which you have seen, and the things which are, and the things which will take place after this.










Technology will make money & prisons obsolete





The Fear

Rev 1:17







"... he (John) is looking at the Ancient of Days.

He's looking at God, whose countenance shines

like the sun.

He's looking into the eyes of the judge of all the earth,

Greatly Afraid: most translations render that phrase: "terrified"

It's the normal reaction of someone who has really seen the resurrected, ascended, glorified Christ: awesome fear, holy fright.


Assurance... Rev 1:17




Assurance... Rev 1:17c


Come to the Living One
