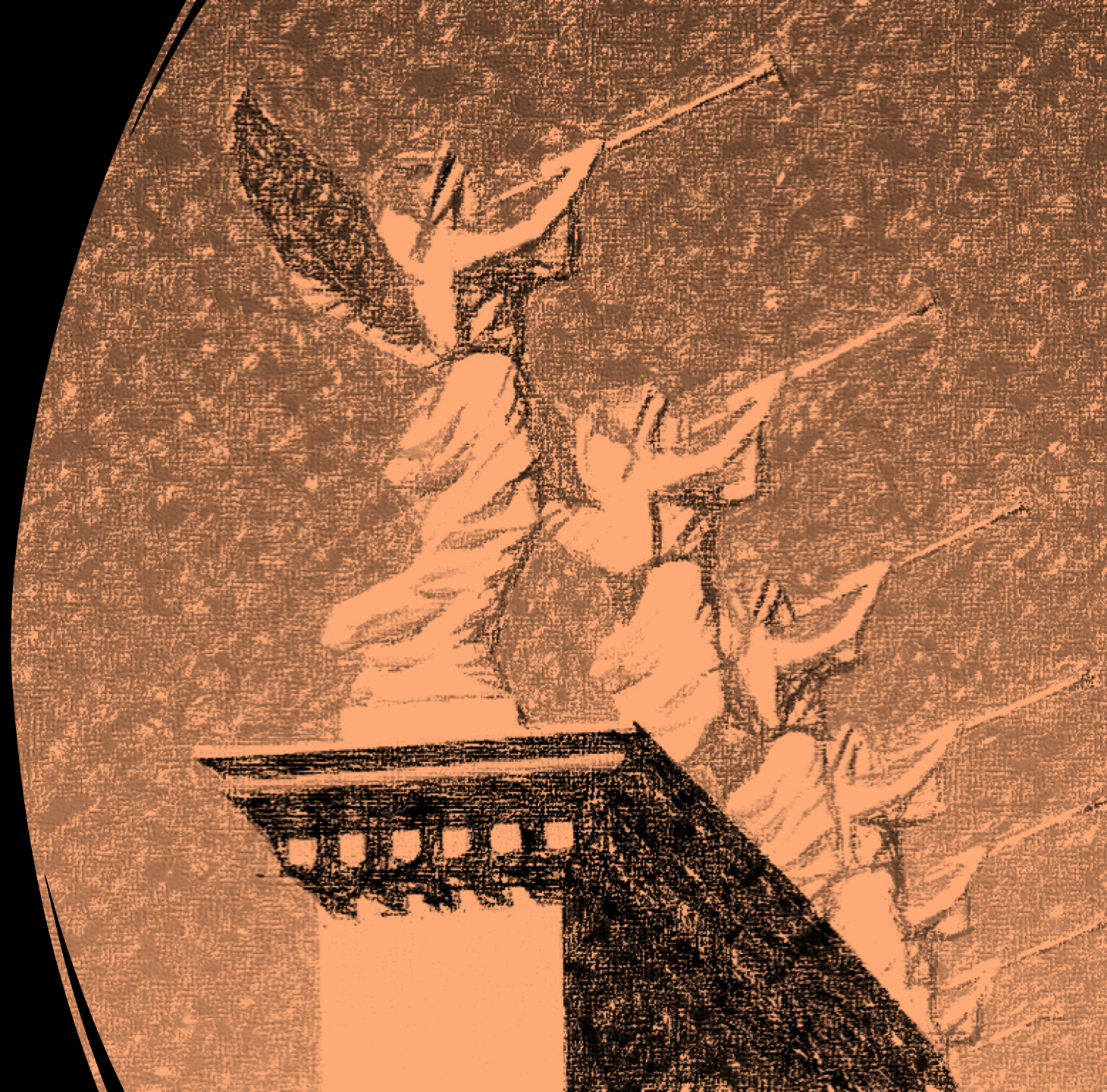
Introduction

“Loud” = “great”

“...there were mighty voices in heaven,

“A crescendo of voices” (MSG)

Cast out – expelled by force

Rewarder

Heb 11:6 But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Rev 11:18

Rewarder

Any rewards or honor we gain in heaven will be precious to us because they carry the weight and meaning of our relationship with God—and because they remind us of what He did through us on earth.
