Call to the Word

Now a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a garland of twelve stars. Then being with child, she cried out in labor and in pain to give birth. And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great, fiery red dragon having seven heads and ten horns, and seven diadems on his heads.



Call to the Word

His tail drew a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was ready to give birth, to devour her Child as soon as it was born. She bore a male Child who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron. And her Child was caught up to God and His throne.



The Divine Outline

Rev 1:19 Write the things which you have seen (chapter 1) and the things which are (chapters 2-3) and the things which will take place after this (chapters 4-22).



The Tribulation is the seven-year period in the end times in which humanity's decadence and depravity will reach its fullness, with God judging accordingly and where Israel will be brought to recognize and receive her Messiah, Jesus Christ.

Purpose of Judgements

- To judge humanity for its decadence, depravity and pride
- To turn Israel around... to get them to repent of their rejection of Jesus and receive Him as their Messiah, setting up a great time of blessing and restoration.



Hos 5:15 I will return again to My place (the ascension)
Till they acknowledge their offense (rejection of messiah).
Then they will seek My face; In their affliction (tribulation)
they will earnestly (diligently) seek Me."

"Great sign" (megas semeion)

Mega: huge in size and significance

Sign: something that points to something else; a symbol of reality

The Dragon's Tail

Stars are Angels
"...the morning stars sang together,
And all the sons of God shouted for joy..."

Job 38:7

'Drew': NASB – 'swept'... involves the notion of violence... like a tail whip of an alligator, or monitor lizard... "threw them to earth"...



The Dragon's Desire

"stood before the woman... to devour her Child"

Devour: to consume, destroy

What better way to thwart God's plan than to destroy the incarnation... when better to destroy the incarnation than when God is a helpless baby?



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The Child's Desting

...rule all nations with a rod of iron.

Ps 2:6-12

To rule with a rod of iron means to exercise strict authority and control, with an unwavering and firm hand leaving no room for disobedience or dissent. It will be a righteous and just rule for all humanity...



The Child's Desting

...rule all nations with a rod of iron.

"Rule (v5)" literally, "tend as a shepherd" in the sense of caring for the flock setting their well-being is a priority.

ICo 15:51-53; 1Th 4:13-18




Reflection
