

The Fourfold Blessings of Marriage

Some Pharisees came and tried to trap [Jesus] with this question: "Should a man be allowed to divorce his wife for just any reason?"

"Haven't you read the Scriptures?" Jesus replied. "They record that from the beginning 'God made them male and female."

And he said, "This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one.' Since they are no longer two but <u>one</u>, let no one split apart what God has joined together."

In marriage you can expect to experience four unique blessings as evidence of God's favor and guidance.

Wonder. Joy. Intimacy. Purpose.

Wonder

Wonder is about finding joy and excitement in discovering new aspects of your partner, experiencing moments of surprise...

Wonder

...it is marveling at the depth of your bond how precious it is that God has given you the privilege to share the life of one of His jewels.

Wonder

Wonder is a characteristic of a marriage that's consistent with God's design.

Joy

Joy is the profound sense of contentment, and fulfillment that comes from just being in a relationship with your spouse.

Joy

...is expressed through laughter, affection and a deep sense of connection.

Joy

... is characteristic of a marriage that's consistent with God's design

Intimacy

... in marriage refers to a deep, close, and meaningful connection between partners that involves open communication, vulnerability, trust, and mutual understanding.

Intimacy

Sexual intimacy saved for and experienced in marriage creates a sacred space where couples can be their true selves and there is a profound sense of connection and fulfillment.


