Introduction

John the Baptist identifies Jesus as the Lamb who takes away the sin of the world, and there we see a Lamb who would be offered for the world.

Behold the Lamb! Jhn 1:29, Mat 3:13, Mrk 1:9

John's baptism was a baptism of repentance and a pointing to Jesus as the Messiah

**metanoeō:** changing one's mind and one's direction... implying godly sorrow for unbelief and sin and a turning from them unto God and the gospel of Christ.

John's Testimony. Jhn 1:30-31

Jesus Christ, though equal with God in every respect, did not appear on the surface to be an extraordinary man. But make no mistake; He is the Word, the Author of truth in a human body.

"Truth often stares us in the face and we fail to acknowledge Him." (Swindoll)


