




# The Redemption Stories of Judges

We drive out the enemy through practicing the principles and precepts of our faith which are found in His Word and which is proved by our obedience.


**Judges 1:27 / Incomplete Conquest**

Luke 21:19


**Judges 1:27 / Incomplete Conquest**



“Economic Gain over Spiritual Purity”

We often rationalize partial obedience as “practical.” But  
compromise breeds corruption.

**Judges 1:28 / Forced Labor as Compromise**



“Disobedience is Contagious”

Over time, integrity is replaced by pragmatism, and the sin that was once uncomfortable becomes routine.


**Judges 1:29 / Ephraim's Failure**

The Canaanites lived “among” them, showing a **reversal** of  
God’s design.

They were meant to be a holy people, influencing the land—  
not being influenced by it.

1Jn 2:15-16


**Judges 1:30 / Zebulun’s Compromise**



“lived, dwelt *among*”

When we dwell among sin instead of conquering it, we grow desensitized to its danger.

**Judges 1:31-33 / Asher & Napht... Living Among**



Dan isn't compromising... he's being defeated!

Disobedience / compromise leads to lost territory and the enemy remains in power.

**Judges 1:34-36 / Dan Pushed Out**

When success is rooted in compromise, it means a person achieves their goals—but at the cost of their values, integrity, or obedience to God.

- Glorifies self, not God
- Erodes character over time
- Invites God's discipline
- May produce regret or even collapse when the truth is revealed

Root: Mat 4:4-10; Heb 3:13


See God's Goodness in


**God's Goodness**
