# The Blasphemy of the Holy Spirit

**Misunderstood Mission / Mark 3:22, 28-29**

The deeper issue is this: the testimony of the Spirit is that Jesus is the Son of God, the Messiah.

To resist the Spirit is to resist that testimony. To reject His works is ultimately to reject Him.

And if you reject the only One who can save you, where else can you turn for forgiveness?
