






## Grace Lens & Discipleship Lens

You are not a bargain bin purchase; you’re treasured by the King.


Prized – Mat 13:44



Discipleship Lens: Joyfully letting go of lesser things.

- We reorder relationships—loving people best by loving Jesus first (Luke 14:26–27).
- We lose the itch for image and applause (Phil 3:7–8), the comfy conveniences that make us numb and the pull of money and upgrades that outrank trust (Matt 6:33).


Prized – Mat 13:44

Discipleship Lens: Joyfully letting go of lesser things.

- Lose the need to control outcomes instead of following by faith (Prov 3:5–6).
- We lay down our escapes—porn, substances, endless scrolling, overwork—and choose what lasts (1 John 2:15–17).

Discipleship Lens: Joyfully letting go of lesser things.


- We drop grudges and our “right” to the last word (Eph 4:31–32)




## Spiritual Nacre-ing
