The God of the Word is the God who speaks

Gen 1:3

Creation itself comes through the spoken Word of God.

The universe exists because God spoke.

The God of the Word is the God whose voice
brings life, order, and truth.

The God of the Word reveals Himself through Scripture

Ps 119:89, 160

His Word reflects **His nature**.

Because God is truthful, His Word is true.

Because God is faithful, His Word is dependable.

**You cannot separate the character of God
from the Word of God.**

The God of the Word ultimately reveals Himself in Jesus

Jn 1:1, 14; Heb 1:1-2

If you want to know what God is like – look at Christ.

**The Word of God tells us what God says.
The Son of God shows us who God is.**

Jn 14:9

When we open the Word of God, we are not just studying a book – we are encountering the God who wrote it.”

The God who wrote the Word is the same God who became the Word

Jn 1:1

Because He is faithful, what He says is faithful. Because He is true, His Word proves true.

God invites us to call on Him – Jer 33:3

God promises to respond when we seek Him – Ps 50:15

Jesus taught His followers to pray – Mat 6:9; 7:7
